CHURCH OF SAO BENEDITO

It was the first church built in southern Brazil by black slaves devoted to São Benedito, believed to have been constructed between 1600 and 1650. The patron saint is St. Benedict, a black saint whom the slaves called the "Glorious São Benedito"

RUA DA PRAIA

Parallel to the left bank of the Itiberê River, Rua da Praia has the largest concentration of colonial mansions. These centuries-old houses showcase the lines and forms of Portuguese colonization. A highlight is Newton D. de Souza Square with the Sacred Mural of São Francisco das Chagas, by the artist Emir Roth from Paranaguá.

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HARBOR D. PEDRO II

The Port of Paranaguá is considered the largest grain exporter in Brazil and Mercosur. Located inside the Paranaguá Bay, its influence extends to a vast region of Brazil, in addition to being a port for the Mercosur countries.

MERCADO DO CAFÉ

All made of wrought iron with arches and lacework. Today it houses a seafood gastronomic center and typical coastal food. In addition, it serves as a stage for fandango performances every fortnight on Saturdays.

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MERCADO DO ARTESANATO

Built in neo-Renaissance style, it was the city's former fish market and served the fishing community who came to sell their catch there. It operated in the early morning and evening hours. It has been restored to serve as a point of sale for typical regional handicrafts.

SQUARE ROSA ANDRADE

On the banks of the Itiberê River, a mechanical winch was installed, transforming it into a pier for loading boats from the islands, which made the place known as "Pracinha do Guincho".

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THEATER RACHEL COSTA

The old Veiga family mansion was built in 1938. After being abandoned, the property was acquired by the Paranaguá City Hall and, after restoration, the Cine-Theater was erected. Currently with 530 seats, it hosts courses, presentations, concerts, plays, and exhibitions of popular and cultural films.

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ILHA DOS VALADARES

Located 400 meters from the city center, on the right bank of the Itiberê River, the Valadares Island is connected to the mainland by a footbridge. The island is inhabited by fishermen who dedicate themselves to artisanal fishing and cultivate traditions, such as being the stage for the Paraná fandango.

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ILHA DO MEL

The island has 25 kilometers of beautiful beaches, some of them deserted or with little urbanization. The island's population is distributed among several small villages: Encantadas, Nova Brasília, Farol, Praia Grande, and Fortaleza. The main tourist attractions on Ilha do Mel are the Gruta das Encantadas, the Farol das Conchas, and the Fortaleza de N. S. dos Prazeres, all of which are open to the public.
